This programme is designed and run by Speech Pathologists specialising in optimising children's development.

Our Literacy Booster group focuses on phonemic awareness skills. These skills are the building blocks to build reading and writing skills. Children who struggle to identify the alphabet letter sounds, struggle to identify or generate 'real' rhyming words or who find it difficult to build and take apart words, struggle to develop their reading and writing skills, and may not 'enjoy' reading/writing tasks.

These groups will use games and activities to develop and strengthen these building blocks for literacy. Parents will be provided with home activities for additional practice to ensure that skills continue to be strong throughout the school year. Children will learn:

- To quickly identify letter names as well as letter sounds
- Develop rhyming sounds
- To sequence letters in alphabetical order
- To take apart words into their component sounds.
- To build words using the correct sound sequences
